



Wild, luxurious, & eco-friendly vacations

Winner of the 2004 Manitoba Eco-Tourism Award, the High Lake Cabins of Falcon Trails Resort offer luxurious accommodations while being respectful of the environment.

Located in Manitoba's Whiteshell Provincial Park, the two secluded cabins offer the best in environmentally friendly retreats: spectacular views, beautiful workmanship, combined with ecologically sensitive amenities.

"As partners in Falcon Trails, we recognize the value of conserving energy and looking at alternate sources of power," explains Barb Hamilton, one of four Falcon Trails partners. "At the same time, we wanted to create a wilderness experience that respects our surroundings and demonstrates how we can put our beliefs into action."

Both High Lake cabins are solar powered with gravity-fed or on-demand water supplies, and composting toilets. Even the cleaning products used at both High Lake cabins also are environmentally safe. These choices mean guests can enjoy all the amenities while having a minimal impact on the environment, including water quality.

Guests arrive at the cabins by walking, cycling, or cross-country skiing along a beautiful 2.5 km, non-strenuous trail. (Only the guests' gear is transported via a motorized vehicle.) Human power is further encouraged for exploring the area, with each cabin having a canoe for guest use and magnificent, groomed cross-country trails in the winter.

"We see the High Lake cabins as an opportunity for people to experience the wilderness in a way that respects the environment without losing some of the luxuries that make a vacation relaxing," Hamilton adds.



The High Lake cabins are surrounded the Precambrian Shield's rocky outcrops (some dating back 2.5 to 3 billion years) and the boreal forest. Privacy is virtually guaranteed – they are the only 2 cabins on the lake. The only sound visitors are likely to hear are birds and the only other 'visitors' they may see are the animals who live in the area, including owls, wolves, and moose.

The two cabins, both newly constructed, have their own unique design. One cabin is post and beam design while the other features log accents. Fully furnished, both cabins have large windows giving magnificent lake views, as well as a large screened deck and an open deck area (with propane barbecue).
